

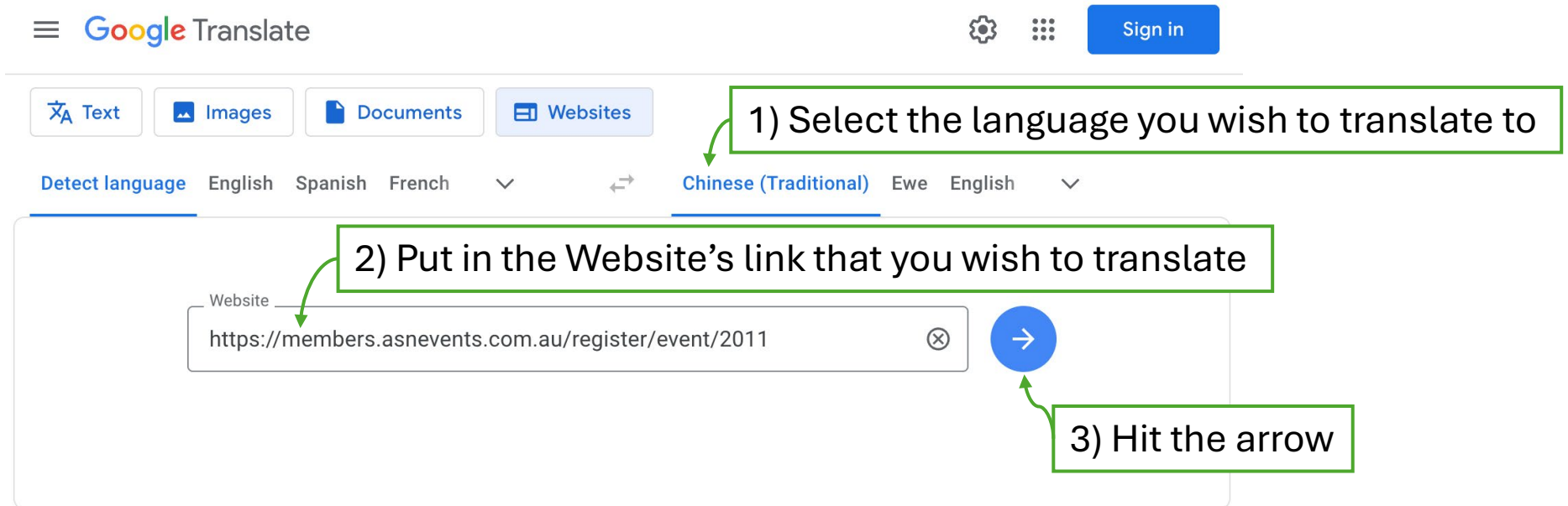


Steps to Translate a Website into Your Preferred Language

USING GOOGLE TRANSLATE

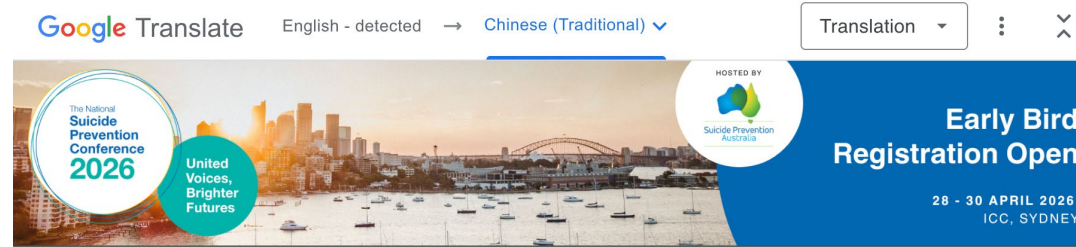
Go to Google Translate

Not working for you?

Why this happens?

You're signed in with a **work or school Google account** (Google Workspace).

Your IT admin has turned off **Google Translate** for your account. When this is blocked, Google shows a banner that says you don't have access.

Other common reasons:

School/under-18 accounts: Translate is turned off by policy.

Managed devices or browsers: Company rules or web filters block translate.google.com or translate.googleapis.com.

Network rules: Translate only works on the **company network or VPN** (Context-Aware Access).

Quick things you can try (now)

- Open a **private/incognito window** and don't sign in to your work/school account.
Or sign in with a **personal Gmail** instead.
- If you're on a **work laptop or school Chromebook**, try from a **personal device** and **home/mobile network**.
- Use another translator for now, like **DeepL** or **Microsoft Translator**.

If none of the above helps, please contact your IT team with the note on the right-hand side.
